- 1. Professor LEE **SHULMAN**, Chairman Professor Shulman is a world renowned scholar in education and President Emeritus of The Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching. He is a past President of the American Educational Research Association (AERA) and a member of the National Academy of Education. Shulman's research deals with the study of teaching and teacher education; the growth of knowledge among those learning to teach; the assessment of teaching; and the psychology of instruction in Science and Mathematics.
- 2. Professor MARCIA **LINN**. Professor of development and cognition specializing in education in mathematics, science, and technology in the Graduate School of Education at the University of California, Berkeley. She is a member of the National Academy of Education and a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the American Psychological Association, and the Association for Psychological Science. Professor Linn earned her Ph. D. at Stanford University
- 3. Mr. Shlomo **Dovrat**. Founder and General Partner of Carmel Ventures. In 2003 Mr. Dovrat was appointed as chairman of a National Task Force for the Advancement of Education in Israel. He is one of the founders of Israel Venture Network, a philanthropic organization led by high-tech executives in Israel.
- 4. Dr. RACHEL **KNOLL**. A physics teacher from the Southern development town of Yeruham. Dr. Knoll received her Ph.D in Physics from the Ben-Gurion University. She founded the Science Teaching Center in her town and established the first Physics Studies track for the school students of Yeruham and the surrounding villages.
- 5. Mr. DANNY **BAR-GIORA**. Former Director of the Jerusalem Education Administration Department, head of the Ministry's unit responsible for implementing the wage agreements with the teacher unions. Previously, Mr. Bar-Giora served as a school principal, and currently he heads the Mandel School for Educational Leadership.
